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In accordance with Texas Supreme Court Order #24-9030, Case Notices will be provided to active attorneys through re:SearchTX once the county is integrated. This may replace the current notice system sent directly by the county. Please note that Case Notices will differ from the optional case alerts that can be set up within re:SearchTX.

### **Key Changes Starting October 1, 2025:**

- Case notices will only be sent from integrated clerk offices.
- Active attorneys will automatically begin receiving Case Notices for activity on their cases.
- Case Notices will be sent to the attorney eService email address registered on your State Barprofile. Profiles should be reviewed and confirmed annually.
- To remove yourself from the active party list, you must file a motion to withdraw or take other appropriate action
